

26. Elena and Freddy Satalaya continue to walk alongside *Iglesia Cristiana Menonita del Perú* (Mennonite Christian Church of Peru), as they wait for Freddy's spouse residency visa. Pray for the United States paperwork to be completed so Matías, who turns one year old today, can become better acquainted with his mother's relatives and so his parents can continue their studies. (p. 29)

27. A couple has been walking alongside a media ministry in the Middle East and Northern Africa for decades. Pray for them as they join a team that finds creative ways of sharing the good news of Jesus in culturally sensitive ways.

28. Pray for Katrina Boulton as she works with LCC International University's summer English program in Lithuania.

29. Cathy Kafutshi is the manager of a Mennonite feeding program for children who were displaced during the violence between government forces and the Kamuina Nsapu about five years ago in Congo. Pray for her and the churches as they help children overcome the effects of trauma in their lives.

30. Christy Harrison and Peter Sensenig and their three children have finished their assignment in Paris, France. Pray for them as they prepare to move to Chad next month and engage with local initiatives in peace education and nurse-midwifery. (p. 21)

- 1.** Jane and Jerrell Ross Richer have returned from a short trip to Ecuador, where they renewed relationships, after a two-year absence due to the pandemic and family circumstances. Pray for them as they discern God's leading for the next steps in their two-way mission. (p. 29)
- 2.** Kate Widmer walks alongside *La Prairie* Mennonite Church in community outreach ministries — working in the congregation's café and bookstore and organizing activities that focus on women and children who have immigrated to France. Pray for her as she transitions from her time in the United States to resuming this ministry. (p. 23)
- 3.** Mennonite church leaders in Angola sometimes feel isolated and exhausted from the demands of ministry. Praise God for a recent visit from the Africa Leadership Coaching Network, a ministry of Africa Inter-Mennonite Mission, a Mission Network partner. Pray that the fellowship and encouragement from Congolese and North American colleagues will strengthen Mennonites in Angola.
- 4.** Pray for the Community Health Evangelism teams in Nepal and surrounding countries. Thank God for a couple, based in Finland, who walk alongside these teams. (p. 13)



- 5.** Mennonite Voluntary Service participants are in their final months at their unit houses and volunteer placements. Pray for them as they bring closure to relationships in their hosting community and find ways to implement what they have learned, as they move into their futures. (p. 37, 38)
- 6.** Delicia Bravo Aguilar and Peter Wigginton are serving in Ecuador, alongside the Quito Mennonite Church. Pray for them as they share their gifts in music, education, podcasting and children's ministries. (p. 27)
- 7.** Martine Audéoud vacated her office apartment in France to make space for Ukrainian refugees, but God sent her a Nigerian refugee family with three children instead. Pray that this family will find support and be able to start a new life. Pray also for Martine as she prepares lectures and counsels doctoral students from her kitchen table. (p. 20)
- 8.** Praise God for the growth of the church in the Batéké region of Congo. Pray especially for the Bitá congregation, which recently celebrated its first anniversary. Ask God to bless the ministries of Deacon Constant Tsona and Deaconess Miryam Makoko.
- 9.** Pray that God will bless Arabic-speaking church leaders who are receiving training at Bethlehem Bible College in Palestine with wisdom and courage to share hope with their people. (p. 11)
- 10.** Mission Network's board is meeting today. Pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit, as 13 board members discern God's leading for the agency.
- 11.** Bolivia Mennonite Church consists of 12 congregations and church plants. Pray for members as they share their faith and engage in ministry, especially for staff, teachers, students and their families at Samuelito Daycare Center in Santa Cruz. (p. 31)
- 12.** Praise God for safety in travel and all the learning and experiences that Naomi Tice had while visiting Israel/Palestine with the German Mennonite Peace Committee. Pray for her as she practices what she learned about faith and justice in her work with the German Mennonite Voluntary Service. (p. 23)
- 13.** Pray for those who made the decision to follow Jesus Christ during evening evangelistic events held by Salvation Mennonite Church in Sierra Leone. Pray also that church members will be active peacemakers, as the country prepares for presidential and parliamentary elections next year.
- 14.** Ask God to provide all the resources necessary for the three Mennonite synods in Indonesia, as they prepare to host Mennonite World Conference 2022 in July. Pray that the global Anabaptist community will be unified and strengthened as a witness to the power of God's love and shalom. (p. 16)
- 15.** Youth Venture's week-long learning and service experiences in July include a civil rights tour in southern states and engaging with immigration realities along the southern border of Arizona. Pray for hosts, leaders and participants as they prepare to live out being God's people in new ways. (p. 41)
- 16.** Alfonsina and José Oyanguren request prayer for a new Toba-Qom church that is being established in a developing neighborhood on the edge of Castelli, Argentina. (p. 29)
- 17.** Praise God for the Center for Justice and Peace, which is providing resources in Anabaptist theology for French-speaking ministries around the world. Pray for Matthew and Toni Krabill as they help coordinate this new ministry from their base at the Paris Mennonite Center in France. (p. 22)
- 18.** SADRA Conflict Transformation partners with Mission Network to train church leaders, communities and students in conflict transformation and social justice in South Africa. Pray for young leader, Zanele Kolo, who is studying at Eastern Mennonite University's Center for Justice and Peacebuilding this summer, and for SADRA director Oscar Siwali as he provides leadership. (p. 11)
- 19.** On this Father's Day, pray for fathers around the world, especially those who lack the support needed to provide life's necessities for their children. May we share what God has given us, acknowledging that we are all part of God's one family.
- 20.** The Service Adventure unit in Jackson, Mississippi, needs leaders for the coming year. Pray that God will call people with a passion for youth and ministry for this unit and for smooth transitions for all units. (p. 39)
- 21.** Mark and Stephanie Bartsch have many opportunities to share Jesus' love as they teach — from pre-school to university levels — and preach in Japan. Pray for them as they discern how to balance their heavy schedules with health and family concerns. (p. 13)
- 22.** The Hermitage, a spiritual retreat center in Michigan, requests SOOP volunteers to join in the community life of prayer and extending hospitality. Pray for people willing to help with meals, housekeeping, garden and yard work, building maintenance, and forestry. (p. 40)
- 23.** Members of Mennonite churches in Venezuela extend the love of Jesus to their neighbors during a time when more than 90% of the population is living in poverty, and more than 75% are experiencing extreme poverty. Pray for the churches as they address both food insecurity and spiritual hunger. (p. 35)
- 24.** Gordon McDade, Karen Sethuraman and Patricia Whitestone are community chaplains with Soul Space, an organization that walks alongside peacemakers in Belfast, Northern Ireland, a city fractured by partisan conflict. Pray for them as they offer hospitable spaces where people can process the traumas they have experienced. (p. 25)
- 25.** Anabaptist Network in South Africa (ANiSA) is a network of people, churches and organizations seeking to embody God's reconciling vision for the world. Pray for ANiSA as members seek to grow communities of peace and justice in their neighborhoods. (p. 11)
